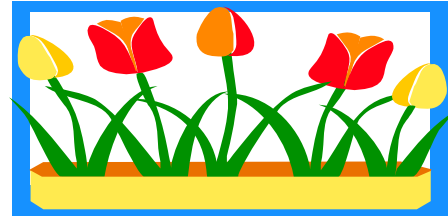

**ABOUT OUR HOST FACILITY:** Galls is a leading Retailer in Uniforms and Hard Goods that services the needs of Police, Fire, Rescue, EMS, Corrections, Military, Border Patrol, and much more. This facility is 400,000 sq ft and is unique in that it houses distribution and some production for items that require value added services under the same roof. About 32 years ago, Mr. Bloomfield purchased Galls from Phillip Galls (a popular sporting goods retailer). He began mailing catalogs from his kitchen table. Now we mail hundreds of thousands of Catalogs and other publications annually as well as maintain a full web program. **Directions:** Galls is located at 1340 Russell Cave Rd. From the inter-loop, turn right onto Russell Cave Rd. and then turn left directly behind Taco Bell into the driveway labeled Aramark. Then veer right towards Galls distribution and turn right into first Parking Lot.
